EVENT GUIDELINES

To help ensure a safe, enjoyable and respectful experience for all visitors, builders, homeowners and neighbors, please observe the following guidelines during your tour.



KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Download the **CNY Parade of Homes App** from the App Store before your visit. Use the app or website (hbrcnyc.com) to view the event map, home descriptions, addresses, and driving directions so you can plan the most efficient route.

Depending on your starting location, most visitors can comfortably tour four to five homes in a day—or more if you prefer a faster pace.



WEAR COMFORTABLE SHOES

Some builders may ask visitors to remove their shoes or wear provided shoe covers. Please follow each builder's instructions and use designated walkways whenever possible.



CHILDREN ARE WELCOME

Children are welcome but must be accompanied and closely supervised by an adult at all times. For the safety of all guests & to help protect the homes, **strollers are not permitted** inside Parade Homes.



NO PETS

Only trained service animals are permitted inside Parade Homes.



NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES

Food, beverages, chewing gum, tobacco products, and vaping are not permitted inside Parade Homes.



PLAN ACCORDINGLY

Public restrooms are **not** available at Parade Homes. Please plan restroom stops as part of your tour.



RESPECT THE HOMES

Please treat every home with care and respect.

Do not sit on furniture, touch walls, or handle decorative items or personal property.



PLEASE DO NOT OPERATE HOME FEATURES

Unless invited by the builder or a Parade representative, please do not open cabinets, closets, appliances, windows, or operate plumbing fixtures, lighting controls, or other home features.



STAY ON DESIGNATED PATHS

Help protect landscaping and respect neighboring properties by using designated parking areas, sidewalks, and walkways.



BE COURTEOUS

Please follow all directions provided by builders, Parade staff, and volunteers. Courtesy and patience help ensure an enjoyable experience for everyone.



ASK QUESTIONS

Builders and their representatives are available throughout the event to answer questions about home design, construction, products, features, pricing, and future building opportunities.



PARKING & NEIGHBORHOOD COURTESY

Please obey all municipal parking regulations and ensure emergency vehicle access is never obstructed. Be considerate of neighboring homeowners by avoiding blocked driveways, mailboxes, sidewalks, and fire hydrants. Do not use neighboring driveways to turn around, and park only in legal or designated parking areas.



SAFETY FIRST

Please use caution when entering homes and walking through construction areas. Watch your step on stairs, uneven surfaces, and outdoor walkways. Visitors assume responsibility for their own safety while touring the homes.
